

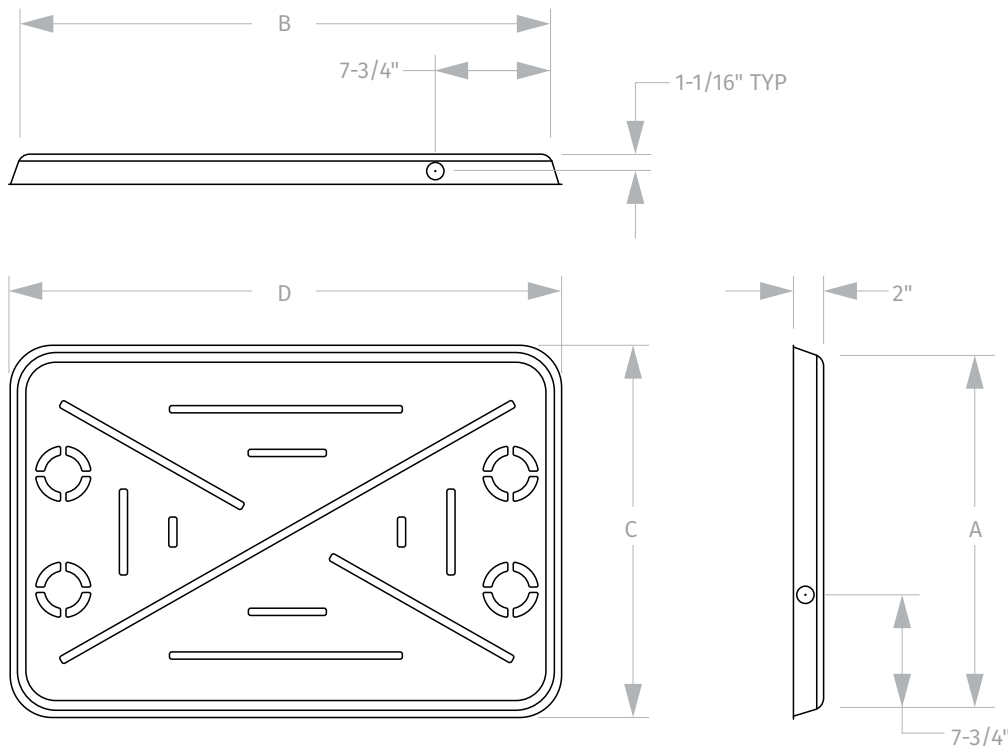

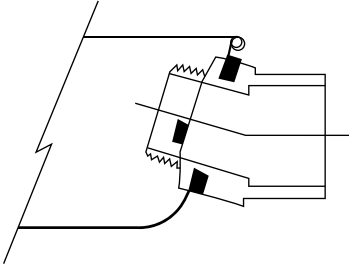

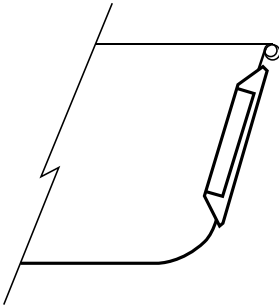
Installation Instructions

Drain Fitting Detail



1. Install black rubber washer on to threaded end of the drain pan coupling.
2. Insert the drain pan fitting with rubber washer from the outside of the drain pan.
3. Install the locking nut onto the threads of the drain pan fitting on the inside of the drain pan.

Hole Plug Installation Detail



1. Install rubber hole plug from the outside of the drain pan.
2. Make sure that the back flange of the rubber hole plug is completely inserted into the hole.
3. Ensure the back flange of the rubber hole plug is completely flush with inside of the drain pan surface.
